JORGE L. PARAS, M.D., : AND ORDER  
RESPONDENT. :  
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Based upon the attached Stipulation, the Wisconsin Medical Examining Board hereby makes and enters the following Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law and Order:

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. That JORGE L. PARAS, M.D., Respondent herein, is a physician licensed to practice medicine and surgery in the State of Wisconsin; that his license which bears number 13146 was granted September 9, 1958; that he has not been registered to practice medicine and surgery in the State of Wisconsin since December 31, 1972; that his current address is 2216 Seventh Avenue, #A-318, Pueblo, Colorado 81008.

2. That on November 11, 1981 Respondent entered into a Stipulation with the Colorado State Board of Medical Examiners by which Respondent voluntarily surrendered his license to practice medicine in the State of Colorado. A copy of that Stipulation and Order is attached hereto and marked Exhibit A.

3. That among other things Respondent agreed, in that Stipulation, not to seek relicensure in Colorado until such time as he submitted proof acceptable to that Board that he no longer suffers from any physical or mental disability which renders him incapable to perform medical services with reasonable skill and safety to his patients.

4. That at the time Respondent entered into the Stipulation with the Colorado State Board of Medical Examiners, Respondent was suffering from post-operation organic brain syndrome, which physical and mental condition rendered him unable to perform medical services with reasonable skill and with safety to his patients.

5. To this date, Respondent has not been relicensed to practice medicine by the State of Colorado.

6. That Respondent is currently in a program to rehabilitate his physical and mental condition.

7. That Respondent has not practiced medicine and surgery in Wisconsin since 1972.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

1. That the Wisconsin Medical Examining Board has jurisdiction over this matter pursuant to section 448.02, Wis. Stats.

2. That the Wisconsin Medical Examining Board has authority to enter into the attached Stipulation pursuant to section 227.07(5), Wis. Stats.

ORDER

NOW THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that Respondent, JORGE L. PARAS, M.D., shall not be registered or re-registered to practice medicine and surgery in the State of Wisconsin until such time as he either:


1. Submits acceptable proof to the Wisconsin Medical Examining Board that he has been fully relicensed to practice medicine in the State of Colorado, without any limitations, or

2. Submits other proof acceptable to the Wisconsin Medical Examining Board that he no longer suffers from any physical or mental disability which renders him incapable to perform medical services with reasonable skill and with safety to his patients.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, that the Disciplinary Complaint in this matter is dismissed.
