Based upon the attached Stipulation of the parties, the Wisconsin Medical Examining Board hereby makes and enters the following:

ORDER

NOW THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that the Wisconsin Medical Examining Board hereby accepts and approves the attached Stipulation.


IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Department of Regulation and Licensing, Division of Enforcement, investigative file 84 MED 138 is closed.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Robert F. McIntyre, M.D., Licensee, shall immediately surrender to the United States Drug Enforcement Administration or its representatives his DEA registration, and all controlled substances and all unused DEA 222 Order Forms, in his possession or control.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Wisconsin Medical Examining Board hereby accepts the voluntary surrender of Robert F. McIntyre's license to practice medicine and surgery in the State of Wisconsin.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that if at any time Licensee makes application for a license to practice medicine and surgery in the State of Wisconsin that he shall, at the time he makes application, take and pass all examinations required for original licensure, and shall comply with all terms and conditions for licensure as the Wisconsin Medical Examining Board may deem appropriate, including but not limited to requiring proof from Licensee that he is mentally and physically competent to practice medicine and surgery.
