A party aggrieved by this decision may petition the Board for rehearing within twenty (20) days after service of this decision pursuant to Wis. Stats. sec. 227.12. The petition in this instance would be captioned with Thomas W. Dull, O.D. as the respondent.

A party aggrieved by this decision who is a resident of this state may also petition for judicial review by filing the petition in the office of the clerk of the circuit court for the county where the party aggrieved resides within thirty (30) days after service of this decision. A party aggrieved by this decision who is not a resident of this state must file the petition for judicial review in the office of the clerk of circuit court for Dane County. A party aggrieved must also serve the board and other parties with a copy of the petition for judicial review within thirty (30) days after service of this decision pursuant to Wis. Stats. sec. 227.16. The party to be named as respondent in the petition is the State of Wisconsin Optometry Examining Board.

The parties in this matter agree to the terms and conditions of the attached Stipulation as the final disposition of this matter, subject to the approval of the Board. The Board has reviewed this Stipulation and considers it acceptable.

Accordingly, the Board in this matter adopts the attached Stipulation.

Therefore, it is hereby ORDERED:

The pending disciplinary proceeding against the license of Thomas W. Dull, O.D., is DISMISSED on its merits.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Thomas W. Dull register for and take the Wisconsin practical (performance) optometry examination when it is given in Jane, 1985. Notification of exam results shall be by mail and addressed to Dr. Dull at P. O. Box 383, Richland Center, WI 53581, as well as to Dr. Dull c/o his attorney, John J. McLario, N88 W16783 Main Street, Menomonee Falls, WI 53051.

If Dr. Dull fails to successfully pass this examination, his license to practice optometry in the State of Wisconsin shall be suspended immediately upon notification of examination failure. The suspension shall remain in effect until such time as Dr. Dull successfully completes the practical examination. In the event that Dr. Dull does fail the Jane examination, the Board agrees to provide Dr. Dull with an opportunity for re-examination at its next scheduled Board meeting in July, 1985.
