ORDER

Based upon the attached Stipulation of the parties, the Wisconsin Medical Examining Board hereby orders as follows:


NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that the Stipulation of the parties, attached to this Order is accepted by the Wisconsin Medical Examining Board.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Wisconsin Department of Regulation and Licensing, Division of Enforcement, investigative file 84 MED 243, regarding John Harry Gunkel, M.D., is hereby closed.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that John Harry Gunkel, M.D., Licensee, be and hereby is Reprimanded for his failure to take the requisite number of continuing medical education credits during 1982-83, prior to registering for the 1984-85 biennium.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that if Licensee registers to practice medicine and surgery in the State of Wisconsin for the 1986-87 biennium, that Licensee must provide verification to the Medical Examining Board that he has taken 56 Category I AMA or AOA continuing medical education credits during 1984 and 1985. The 56 credits constitute the 26 credits which Licensee failed to retain verification of having taken during 1982 and 1983, in addition to the 30 credits required for each biennium.
