The Wisconsin Medical Examining Board having met on June 20, 1985, and having received and considered a STIPULATION, a copy of which is attached hereto and incorporated herein;


And the Wisconsin Medical Examining Board having determined that it has jurisdiction to act in this matter pursuant to Wis. Stats. Secs. 448.02(3) and 448.02(5);

NOW THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED THAT:

1. The terms of the attached STIPULATION are approved and adopted by the Wisconsin Medical Examining Board.
2. The Wisconsin Medical Examining Board accepts the voluntary surrender of Philip Winskunas' current registration to practice medicine and surgery in the State of Wisconsin, effective on the date of this Order, and closes the pending investigation #84MED183 without further action.
3. If at any time Philip Winskunas makes application for reregistration of his license to practice medicine and surgery in the State of Wisconsin, he shall comply with all of the then-existing requirements for reregistration and, as a prerequisite for reregistration, he shall take and pass an oral examination before the Wisconsin Medical Examining Board.
