A party aggrieved by this decision may petition the Board for rehearing within twenty (20) days after service of this decision pursuant to Wis. Stats. sec. 227.12. The petition in this instance would be captioned with Patsy Jackson, LPN as the respondent.

A party aggrieved by this decision who is a resident of this state may also petition for judicial review by filing the petition in the office of the clerk of the circuit court for the county where the party aggrieved resides within thirty (30) days after service of this decision. A party aggrieved by this decision who is not a resident of this state must file the petition for judicial review in the office of the clerk of circuit court for Dane County. A party aggrieved must also serve the board and other parties with a copy of the petition for judicial review within thirty (30) days after service of this decision pursuant to Wis. Stats. sec. 227.16. The party to be named as respondent in the petition is the State of Wisconsin Board of Nursing.

The parties in this matter agree to the terms and conditions of the attached stipulation as the final disposition of this matter, subject to the approval of the Board. The Board has reviewed this Stipulation and considers it acceptable.

Accordingly, the Board in this matter adopts the attached stipulation and makes the following:

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### FINDINGS OF FACT

- 1. Patsy Jackson is duly licensed in the State of Wisconsin as a licensed practice nurse (license #18628; issued March 18, 1977.)
- 2. At all time relevant to this action, Ms. Jackson was working as a licensed practical nurse at AMS Greentree Health Care Center, 6925 North Port Washington Road, Greendale, Wisconsin.
- 3. On an exact date unknown, but sometime during the month of August, 1983 Ms. Jackson threatened to use a restraint on a resident when the resident attempted to go to bed before the time recommended in the resident's plan of care.
- 4. The plan of care recommended keeping the resident up for two hours following her evening meal, in order to promote a more normal sleep pattern.
- 5. The threat of restraint by Ms. Jackson was not an appropriate nursing intervention.
- 6. As a result of this incident, Ms. Jackson's employment AMS Greentree was terminated.

### CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

By the conduct described above, Ms. Jackson is subject to disciplinary action against her license, pursuant to Wis. Stats. sec. 441.07(1)(c) and (d), and Wis. Adm. Code secs. N 11.03(1)(f) and N 11.04(1).

Therefore, it is hereby ORDERED:

Ms. Patsy Jackson, L.P.N. is REPRIMANDED.

IN THE MATTER OF THE LICENSE OF

STIPULATION

PATSY JACKSON, L.P.N., RESPONDENT.

It is herby stipulated between Patsy Jackson, LPN, personally on her own behalf and Steven M. Gloe, Attorney for the Department of Regulation and Licensing, Division of Enforcement, as follows that:

- 1. This stipulation is entered into as a result of pending investigation of Ms. Jackson's licensure by the Division of Enforcement (case file #83 NURSE 83). Ms. Jackson consents to the resolution of this investigation by stipulation and without the issuance of a formal complaint.
- 2. Ms. Jackson understands that by the signing of this stipulation she voluntarily and knowingly waives her rights, including: the right to a hearing on the allegations against her, at which time the state has the burden of proving those allegations by clear, satisfactory and convincing evidence; the right confront and cross-examine the witnesses against her; the right to call witnesses on her behalf and to compel their attendance by subpoena; the right to testify herself; the right to file objections to any proposed decision and to present briefs or oral arguments to the officials who are to surrender the final decision; the right to petition for rehearing; and all other applicable rights afforded to Ms. Jackson under the United States constitution, the Wisconsin constitution, the Wisconsin Statutes and the Wisconsin Administrative Code.
- 3. Ms. Jackson agrees to the adoption of the attached Final Decision and Order by the Board of Nursing.
- 4. If the terms of this stipulation are not acceptable to the Board, the parties shall not be bound by the contents of this stipulation, and the matter shall be returned to the Division of Enforcement for further proceedings.
- 5. If the board accepts the terms of this stipulation, the parties to the stipulation consent to the entry of the attached Final Decision and Order without further notice, pleading, appearance or consent of the parties.

6. The Division of Enforcement joins Ms. Jackson in recommending the Board of Nursing adopt this stipulation and issue the attached Final Decision and Order.
