The parties in this matter agree to the terms and conditions of the attached Stipulation as the final disposition of this matter, subject to the approval of the Board. The Board has reviewed this Stipulation and considers it acceptable.

Accordingly, the Board in this matter adopts the attached Stipulation and makes the following:

FINDINGS OF FACT

- 1. Louis Floch, 5625 Washington Avenue, Racine, Wisconsin 53406, is a physician duly licensed and currently registered to practice medicine and surgery in the State of Wisconsin under license #15200 which was granted on March 2, 1965.
- 2. Louis Floch, M.D., was born on August 7, 1930, and specialized in the practice of obstetrics and gynecology.
- 3. That on December 31, 1989, Louis Floch, M.D., retired from the active practice of medicine and surgery in the State of Wisconsin.
- 4. An investigation of Louis Floch, M.D., is currently pending before the Wisconsin Medical Examining Board under investigative file #88 MED 199. This investigation commenced upon routine referral from the Office of the Commissioner of Insurance for malpractice claims paid.
- 5. Louis Floch, M.D., in consideration of his retirement from the practice of medicine and surgery, hereby voluntarily surrenders his current register to practice medicine and surgery in the State of Wisconsin, and agrees that he will not make application for reregistration in the future.

- 6. In consideration of the agreements set forth in paragraph 5 above, it is hereby recommended that the Wisconsin Medical Examining Board accept the voluntary surrender of Louis Floch's current registration to practice medicine and surgery in the State of Wisconsin and to close the pending investigative file without further proceedings or commencement of any formal disciplinary actions based upon the investigation.
- 7. Louis Floch, M.D., will not practice or attempt to practice medicine and surgery in the State of Wisconsin when not currently registered.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

1. The Wisconsin Medical Examining Board has jurisdiction in this proceeding pursuant to Wis. Stats., secs. 448.02(3) and 227.44(5).

ORDER

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that the Stipulation of the parties is approved.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Respondent shall, within 30 days of the effective date of this Order, surrender his current registration to the Medical Examining Board.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Respondent shall not make application for reregistration to practice medicine and surgery in the State of Wisconsin in the future, and shall not practice medicine and surgery at any time when not currently registered.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that pursuant to the authority of Wis. Stats., secs. 448.02(4), should the Medical Examining Board determine that there is probable cause to believe that Louis Floch, M.D., has violated the terms of the Final Decision and Order of the Medical Examining Board, the Board may order that the license of Louis Floch, M.D., to practice medicine and surgery in the State of Wisconsin be summarily suspended pending investigation of the alleged violation.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the investigative file #88 MED 199 be closed without further proceedings or commencement of any formal disciplinary action based upon this investigation.

NOTICE OF APPEAL INFORMATION

(Notice of Rights for Rehearing or Judicial Review, the times allowed for each and the identification of the party to be named as respondent)

The following notice is served on you as part of the final decision:

1. Rehearing.

Any person aggrieved by this order may petition for a rehearing within 20 days of the service of this decision, as provided in section 227.49 of the Wisconsin Statutes, a copy of which is attached. The 20 day period commences the day after personal service or mailing of this decision. (The date of mailing of this decision is shown below.) The petition for rehearing should be filed with the State of Wisconsin Medical Examining Board.

A petition for rehearing is not a prerequisite for appeal directly to circuit court through a petition for judicial review.

2. Judicial Review.

Any person aggrieved by this decision has a right to petition for judicial review of this decision as provided in section 227.53 of the Wisconsin Statutes, a copy of which is attached. The petition should be filed in circuit court and served upon the State of Wisconsin Medical Examining Board.
