ORDER ADOPTING STIPULATION

DILIP KUMAR DAS, M.D., RESPONDENT.

The Medical Examining Board received a stipulation in the above-captioned matter executed by Dilip Kumar Das, M.D. and Pamela M. Stach, Attorney for the Department of Regulation and Licensing, Division of Enforcement. Based upon the Stipulation, the Medical Examining Board makes the following findings of fact, conclusions of law and order.

FINDINGS OF FACT

- 1. Dilip Kumar Das, 15/Inrisingha Dutta Road, Sakherbazar, Calcutta-8, India 700008, is a physician duly licensed but not currently registered to practice medicine and surgery in the State of Wisconsin under license #19001, said license having been granted on July 23, 1974.
- 2. An investigation of Dilip Kumar Das, M.D. is currently pending before the Medical Examining Board, file numbers 87 MED 173 and 90 MED 236.
- 3. Dilip Kumar Das, M.D. presently resides in India and has no intention of returning to the United States to practice Medicine or Surgery.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

1. The Medical Examining Board has jurisdiction in this matter pursuant to Wis. Stats., sec. 448.02.

The Medical Examining Board may enter into stipulated resolutions pursuant to Wis. Stats., sec. 448.02(5).

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that the voluntary surrender of the license to practice medicine and surgery in the State of Wisconsin of Dilip Kumar Das, M.D. is hereby accepted.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, that investigative files 87 MED 173 and 90 MED 236 are hereby closed.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, that in the regular case that in the event Dilip Kumar Das makes application for relicensure at any time in the future, he shall take and pass all examinations then required for original licensure and shall comply with all terms and conditions that the Medical Examining Board may deem appropriate.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, that pursuant to the authority of sec. 448.02(4), Wis. Stats., should the Wisconsin Medical Examining Board determine that there is probable cause to believe that Dilip Kumar Das, M.D. has violated the terms of the Final Decision and Order of the Medical Examining Board or the Stipulation upon which it is based, the Medical Examining Board may order that the license of Dilip Kumar Das, M.D. to practice medicine and surgery in the State of Wisconsin be summarily suspended pending investigation of the alleged violation.

STIPULATION

DILIP KUMAR DAS, M.D., RESPONDENT.

It is hereby stipulated between Dilip Kumar Das, M.D. and Pamela M. Stach, Attorney for the Department of Regulation and Licensing, Division of Enforcement, as follows:

- 1. Dilip Kumar Das, 15/Inrisingha Dutta Road, Sakherbazar, Calcutta-8, India 700008, is a physician duly licensed but not currently registered to practice medicine and surgery in the State of Wisconsin under license #19001, said license having been granted on July 23, 1974.
- 2. There are currently pending before the Medical Examining Board, two investigations, 87 MED 173 and 90 MED 236, regarding the care and treatment Dilip Kumar Das, M.D., provided two patients.
- 3. Dilip Kumar Das, M.D. presently resides in India and has no intention of returning to the United States to practice Medicine or Surgery.
- 4. In consideration of the above, Dilip Kumar Das, M.D. agrees to voluntarily surrender his license to practice medicine and surgery in the State of Wisconsin.
- 5. In consideration of the above, the Division of Enforcement hereby moves the Medical Examining Board to close all pending investigations regarding Dilip Kumar Das, M.D. upon acceptance of his voluntary surrender of his license to practice medicine and surgery in the State of Wisconsin.
- 6. If, at any time in the future, Dilip Kumar Das, M.D., makes application for relicensure to practice medicine and surgery in the State of Wisconsin, he shall take and pass all examinations then required for original licensure and shall comply with all terms and conditions that the Medical Examining Board may deem appropriate.
- 7. The parties to this Stipulation may appear before the Medical Examining Board to argue on behalf of acceptance of this Stipulation.

If any term or condition of this Stipulation is not approved by the Medical Examining Board, then no term of this Stipulation shall be binding in any manner on any party.

NOTICE OF APPEAL INFORMATION

(Notice of Rights for Rehearing or Judicial Review, the times allowed for each, and the identification of the party to be named as respondent)

The following notice is served on you as part of the final decision:

1. Rehearing.

Any person aggrieved by this order may petition for a rehearing within 20 days of the service of this decision, as provided in section 227.49 of the Wisconsin Statutes, a copy of which is attached. The 20 day period commences the day after personal service or mailing of this decision. (The date of mailing of this decision is shown below.) The petition for rehearing should be filed with the State of Wisconsin Medical Examining Board.

A petition for rehearing is not a prerequisite for appeal directly to circuit court through a petition for judicial review.

2. Judicial Review.

Any person aggrieved by this decision has a right to petition for judicial review of this decision as provided in section 227.53 of the Wisconsin Statutes, a copy of which is attached. The petition should be filed in circuit court and served upon the State of Wisconsin Medical Examining Board

within 30 days of service of this decision if there has been no petition for rehearing, or within 30 days of service of the order finally disposing of the petition for rehearing, or within 30 days after the final disposition by operation of law of any petition for rehearing.

The 30 day period commences the day after personal service or mailing of the decision or order, or the day after the final disposition by operation of the law of any petition for rehearing. (The date of mailing of this decision is shown below.) A petition for judicial review should be served upon, and name as the respondent, the following: the State of Wisconsin Medical Examining Board.
