ORDER AMENDING THE FINAL DECISION AND ORDER

The Medical Examining Board issued its Final Decision and Order on October 24, 1991. By the terms of the board's Order, Dr. Sierra was assessed costs, and was to have paid the assessed costs within 60 days following the date of the board's Order. The hearing examiner's Affidavit of Costs was received on October 29, 1991. The Affidavit of Costs for the Division of Enforcement, however, though dated November 1, 1991, was not received in the board office until December 17, 1991. Accordingly,

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that the final paragraph of the Final Decision and Order in this matter dated October 24, 1991, is hereby modified to read as follows:

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Dr. Sierra pay the costs incurred by the Department and board in the prosecution of this action, and if he fails to pay the costs on or before February 18, 1992, his license will be summarily suspended, under sec. 440.22(3), Wis. Stats.




