The parties in this matter, Robert L. Beilman, M.D., Respondent and Pamela M. Stach, Attorney for Complainant, agree to the terms and conditions of the attached Stipulation as final disposition of this matter, subject to approval of the Medical Examining Board. The Board has reviewed the Stipulation and considers it acceptable.

Accordingly, the Medical Examining Board adopts the attached Stipulation and makes the following:

FINDINGS OF FACT

- 1. Robert L. Beilman, M.D., of 4510 Woods End, Madison, Wisconsin 53711 is a physician duly licensed and currently registered to practice medicine and surgery in the State of Wisconsin under license number 12643 which was granted on July 15, 1957.
- 2. Robert L. Beilman, M.D., was born on November 8, 1925 and during the course of his medical practice, specialized in the area of internal medicine.
- 3. On June 12, 1992, Robert L. Beilman, M.D., retired from the active practice of medicine and surgery in the State of Wisconsin.
- 4. An investigation of Robert L. Beilman, M.D. is currently pending before the Wisconsin Medical Examining Board under investigative file number 92 MED 225.

- In consideration of his retirement from the practice of medicine and 5. surgery, Robert L. Beilman, M.D. agrees to surrender his current registration to practice medicine and surgery in the State of Wisconsin and agrees that he will not make application for reregistration at any time in the future.
- In consideration of his retirement from the practice of medicine and surgery in the State of Wisconsin, Robert L. Beilman, M.D. agrees to surrender his current DEA registration, and agrees that he will not make reapplication for reregistration in the future.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

The Wisconsin Medical Examining Board has jurisdiction in this proceeding pursuant to Wis. Stats., secs. 448.02(3) and 227.44(5).

ORDER

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED, that the Stipulation of the parties is accepted.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, that Robert L. Beilman, M.D., shall, within thirty (30) days of the effective date of this Order, surrender his current registration to practice medicine and surgery in the State of Wisconsin to the Medical Examining Board.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, that Robert L. Beilman, M.D. shall, within thirty (30) days of the effective date of this Order, surrender his current DEA registration to the Drug Enforcement Administration.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, that Robert L. Beilman, M.D., shall not make application for reregistration to practice medicine and surgery in the State of Wisconsin or reregistration for a DEA registration number at any time in the future, and shall not practice medicine and surgery when not currently registered.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, that pursuant to the authority of Wis. Stats., sec. 448.02(4), should the Medical Examining Board determine that there is probable cause to believe that Robert L. Beilman, M.D., has violated the terms of this Final Decision and Order, the Board may take such action as is provided pursuant to the authority of Wis. Stats., sec. 448.02(4).

It is hereby stipulated between Robert L. Beilman, M.D., and Pamela M. Stach, Attorney for the Department of Regulation and Licensing, Division of Enforcement, as follows:

- 1. Robert L. Beilman, M.D., of 4510 Woods End, Madison, Wisconsin 53711 is a physician duly licensed and currently registered to practice medicine and surgery in the State of Wisconsin under license number 12643 which was granted on July 15, 1957.
- 2. Robert L. Beilman, M.D., was born on November 8, 1925 and during the course of his medical practice, specialized in the area of internal medicine.
- 3. On June 12, 1992, Robert L. Beilman, M.D., retired from the active practice of medicine and surgery in the State of Wisconsin.
- 4. An investigation of Robert L. Beilman, M.D. is currently pending before the Wisconsin Medical Examining Board under investigative file number 92 MED 225.
- 5. In consideration of his retirement from the practice of medicine and surgery, Robert L. Beilman, M.D. agrees to surrender his current registration to practice medicine and surgery in the State of Wisconsin and agrees that he will not make application for reregistration at any time in the future.
- 6. In consideration of his retirement from the practice of medicine and surgery in the State of Wisconsin, Robert L. Beilman, M.D. agrees to surrender his current DEA registration, and agrees that he will not make reapplication for reregistration in the future.
- 7. The Division of Enforcement recommends that the Wisconsin Medical Examining Board adopt this Stipulation and issue the attached Final Decision and Order in resolution of this matter.
- 8. Violation of the terms and conditions specified in this Stipulation and Final Decision and Order shall constitute a basis for disciplinary action by the Medical Examining Board.
- 9. The parties to this Stipulation understand that the Department of Regulation and Licensing, Division of Enforcement will take no further action against Respondent's license based on the allegations contained in the pending investigative file unless Robert L. Beilman, M.D. violates the terms and conditions of this Stipulation and Final Decision and Order in which event the Department may reopen the investigation and reinstitute proceedings against Robert L. Beilman, M.D.

- 10. This Stipulation and Final Decision and Order, if adopted and entered by the Medical Examining Board, shall become effective on the date of signing.
- 11. In the event any term or condition of this Stipulation and Final Decision and Order is not accepted or entered by the Medical Examining Board, then no term of this Stipulation; and Final Decision and Order shall be binding in any manner on any party to this Stipulation.



NOTICE OF APPEAL INFORMATION

(Notice f Rights for Rehearing r Judicial Review, the times allowed for each, and the identification of the party to be named as respondent)

The following notice is served on you as part of the final decision:

1. Rehearing.

Any person aggrieved by this order may petition for a rehearing within 20 days of the service of this decision, as provided in section 227.49 of the Wisconsin Statutes, a copy of which is attached. The 20 day period commences the day after personal service or mailing of this decision. (The date of mailing of this decision is shown below.) The petition for rehearing should be filed with

A petition for rehearing is not a prerequisite for appeal directly to circuit court through a petition for judicial review.

2. Judicial Review.

Any person aggrieved by this decision has a right to petition f r judicial review of this decision as provided in section 227.53 of the Wisconsin Statutes, a copy of which is attached. The petition should be filed in circuit court and served upon the State of Wisconsin Medical Examining Board.

within 30 days of service of this decision if there has been no petiti n for rehearing, or within 30 days of service of the order finally disposing of the petition for rehearing, or within 30 days after the final disposition by operation of law of any petition for rehearing.

The 30 day period commences the day after personal service or mailing of the decision or order, or the day after the final disposition by operation of the law of any petition for rehearing. (The date of mailing of this decision is shown below.) A petition for judicial review should be served upon, and name as the respondent, the following: the State of Wisconsin Medical Examining Board.
