ORDER GRANTING PETITION

On July 20, 1993, the Medical Examining Board filed its Final Decision and Order in the above-captioned matter. By the terms of the board's Order, Dr. Beaver's license to practice medicine and surgery in Wisconsin was limited in part to require that within three months of the date of the Order, Dr. Beaver complete an assessment and evaluation of his knowledge and skills in the practice of medicine at the University of Wisconsin School of Medicine, Continuing Education Program.


On September 29, 1993, the board received a letter from Sarah Aslaksan, Program Administrator for Continuing Medical Education, indicating that they had been unable to arrange for Dr. Beaver's assessment by the ordered deadline due to the absence of Dr. Thomas D. Meyer, Program Director. An extension of the deadline was requested. The board considered the matter at its meeting of October 20, 1993, and orders as follows:

ORDER

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that paragraph 1. of the Order of the board set forth in the board's Final Decision and Order in this matter dated July 20, 1993, is hereby amended to read as follows:

1. Dr. Beaver shall, on or before February 1, 1994, complete an assessment and evaluation of his knowledge and skills in the practice of medicine as outlined in Exhibit 1. The assessment shall be conducted by the University of Wisconsin School of Medicine, Continuing Medical Education Program.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that paragraph 3. of the Order of the board set forth in the board's Final Decision and Order in this matter dated July 20, 1993, is hereby amended to read as follows:



3. If the assessment referred to in paragraph 1., above, indicates a need for further training and education, Dr. Beaver shall by November 1, 1994, participate and successfully complete an educational program established through the University of Wisconsin School of Medicine, Continuing Medical Education Program. The educational program shall be designed to specifically address any deficiencies revealed in the assessment report. Dr. Beaver shall complete this educational program in addition to his required continuing medical education credits under sec. 448.13, Stats.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that all other terms and conditions of the board's Final Decision and Order in this matter dated July 20, 1993, shall remain in full force and effect.
