MEMORANDUM AND ORDER ON SETTLEMENT CONFERENCE

An informal settlement conference was conducted in the above-captioned matter before an informal settlement committee of the Professional Engineers Section of the board on June 3, 1993. The purpose of the conference was to provide interested parties with an opportunity to discuss allegations received pertaining to the practice of Mr. Conrad as a professional engineer, and to attempt to reach a fair and consensual resolution of the matter

Mr. Conrad appeared in person and without legal counsel. The committee consisted of Mark E. Nurczyk, P.E., and Marvin F. DeVries, P.E. Others present included Roger R. Hall, attorney for the Department of Regulation & Licensing, Division of Enforcement, and Wayne Austin, the board's legal counsel.

The parties orally presented their respective positions regarding the matter to the board, and the board deliberated on a possible disposition of the matter. The board thereafter presented a proposed Stipulation for Mr. Conrad's consideration, a copy of

which is attached hereto and made a part hereof. The Stipulation was ultimately executed by Mr. Conrad, Mr. Hall and Mr. Nurczyk, board chairman.

Based upon the proceedings at the conference, and upon the Stipulation of the parties, the board enters the following order.

ORDER

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that no discipline shall be imposed.

STIPULATION

Wayne A. Conrad, P.E. (Mr. Conrad), and the Examining Board of Architects, Professional Engineers, Designers and Land Surveyors, Professional Engineers Section, (board), having reached agreement on disposition of the informal complaint identified as 91 ENG 008, agree and stipulate as follows:

- 1. This Stipulation shall be made a part of a Memorandum and Order on Settlement Conference to be issued by the board, and all terms of the Stipulation shall be binding on Mr. Conrad as a part of the board's order.
- 2. This Stipulation and the board's order shall be placed in Mr. Conrad's permanent file, and may be used if there are further complaints against him.
- 3. Mr. Conrad is licensed to practice as a professional engineer in Wisconsin by license #18657, issued on June 5, 1979, and he resides at 2219 Yvonne Street, Waukesha, Wisconsin 53188.
- 4 Mr. Conrad is employed as a professional engineer by Rust Environment & Infrastructure, Inc., Sheboygan, Wisconsin, formerly Donahue & Associates. Mr. Conrad was assigned by Donahue to perform engineering services for the Milwaukee Metropolitan Sewerage District on the District's Water Pollution Abatement Program.
- 5. During 1987 and 1988, Mr. Conrad was assigned to be the resident engineer on several construction projects of the District, including Contract #S50O11. Contract #S50O11 was entitled "South Shore Wastewater Treatment Plant Improvements Phase 1 Solids Handling Facilities Dewatering Building." The prime contractor on the building was C.D. Smith Co., Fond du Lac.
