The parties in this matter agree to the terms and conditions of the attached Stipulation as the final decision of this matter, subject to the approval of the Board. The Board has reviewed this Stipulation and considers it acceptable.

Accordingly, the Board in this matter adopts the attached Stipulation and makes the following:

#### FINDINGS OF FACT

- 1. Respondent Dean David Milosch, R.Ph. (dob 4/9/68) is and was at all times relevant to the facts set forth herein a registered pharmacist licensed in the State of Wisconsin pursuant to license #11689.
- 2. The Respondent did, on November 21, 1992, consult with a colleague who had received a written prescription intended by the prescriber to be for Lortab<sup>TM</sup> liquid for a boy who had broken his arm. Respondent and his colleague read the prescription as Cortef,<sup>TM</sup> and they questioned why the patient would be receiving Corfef.<sup>TM</sup> Respondent's colleague filled the prescription as Cortef,<sup>TM</sup> and gave it to respondent to transfer to the patient's parent. Respondent did transfer it to the parent without a consultation.

### **CONCLUSIONS OF LAW**

- 3. The Wisconsin Pharmacy Examining Board has jurisdiction to act in this matter pursuant to §450.10, Wis. Stats. and is authorized to enter into the attached Stipulation pursuant to §227.44(5), Wis. Stats.
- 4. The conduct described in paragraph 2, above, violated §§ Phar 7.01(1)(a) and 10.03(2), Wis. Adm. Code. Such conduct constitutes unprofessional conduct within the meaning of the Code and statutes.

## **ORDER**

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, that the attached Stipulation is accepted.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, that Dean David Milosch, R.Ph., is REPRIMANDED for his unprofessional conduct in this matter.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, that respondent shall FORFEIT \$100 within 30 days of this order.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, that respondent shall pay COSTS in this matter in the amount of \$100, within 30 days of this order
