The parties in this matter agree to the terms and conditions of the attached Stipulation as the final decision of this matter, subject to the approval of the Board. The Board has reviewed this Stipulation and considers it acceptable.

Accordingly, the Board in this matter adopts the attached Stipulation and makes the following:

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. Janice P. Guyette (D.O.B. 2/11/39) is duly licensed as a practical nurse in the state of Wisconsin (license # 18420). This license was first granted on December 10, 1976.
2. Ms. Guyette's most recent address on file with the Wisconsin Board of Nursing is 27548 Roder Road, Holcombe, WI 54745.
3. On May 1, 1993, Ms. Guyette's Wisconsin nursing registration expired, and Ms. Guyette did not renew her registration until September 3, 1993. During that period of time, Ms. Guyette continued her work as a nurse with Victory Medical Center, Stanley, Wisconsin.
4. In resolution of this matter, Ms. Guyette consents to entry of the following Conclusions of Law and Order.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

By the conduct described above, Janice P. Guyette is subject to disciplinary action against her license to practice as a licensed practical nurse in the state of Wisconsin, pursuant to Wis. Stats. §§441.10 (3) and 441.07(1); and Wis. Adm. Code §N7.04(15).

ORDER

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Janice P. Guyette is REPRIMANDED.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that within thirty (30) days from the date of this Order, Ms. Guyette shall pay partial costs of this proceeding in the amount of seventy-five (\$75.00) dollars. Payment shall be made via check or money order payable to the Wisconsin Department of Regulation and Licensing, PO Box 8935, Madison, WI 53708.

It is hereby stipulated between Janice P. Guyette, personally on her own behalf and James W. Harris, Attorney for the Department of Regulation and Licensing, Division of Enforcement, as follows that:

1. This Stipulation is entered into as a result of a pending investigation of Ms. Guyette's licensure by the Division of Enforcement. Ms. Guyette consents to the resolution of this investigation by stipulation and without the issuance of a formal complaint.

2. Ms. Guyette understands that by the signing of this Stipulation she voluntarily and knowingly waives her rights, including: the right to a hearing on the allegations against her, at which time the state has the burden of proving those allegations by a preponderance of the evidence; the right to confront and cross-examine the witnesses against her; the right to call witnesses on her behalf and to compel their attendance by subpoena; the right to testify her; the right to file objections to any proposed decision and to present briefs or oral arguments to the officials who are to render the final decision; the right to petition for rehearing; and all other applicable rights afforded to her under the United States Constitution, the Wisconsin Constitution, the Wisconsin Statutes, and the Wisconsin Administrative Code.

3. Ms. Guyette is aware of her right to seek legal representation and has been provided the opportunity to seek legal advice prior to signing this stipulation.


4. Ms. Guyette agrees to the adoption of the attached Final Decision and Order by the Wisconsin Board of Nursing. The parties to the Stipulation consent to the entry of the attached Final Decision and Order without further notice, pleading, appearance or consent of the parties. Respondent waives all rights to any appeal of the Board's order, if adopted in the form as attached.

5. If the terms of this Stipulation are not acceptable to the Board, the parties shall not be bound by the contents of this Stipulation, and the matter shall be returned to the Division of Enforcement for further proceedings. In the event that this Stipulation is not accepted by the Board, the parties agree not to contend that the Board has been prejudiced or biased in any manner by the consideration of this attempted resolution.

6. The parties to this stipulation agree that the attorney for the Division of Enforcement and the member of the Board of Nursing assigned as an advisor in this investigation may appear before the Board for the


purposes of speaking in support of this agreement and answering questions that the members of the Board may have in connection with their deliberations on the stipulation.

7. The Division of Enforcement joins Ms. Guyette in recommending that the Board adopt this Stipulation and issue the attached Final Decision and Order.
