ORDER RENEWING THE LIMITED LICENSE

On May 27, 1993, the Medical Examining Board issued its Final Decision and Order in the above-captioned matter. By the terms of the board's order, respondent's license to practice medicine and surgery in Wisconsin was limited to require, among other conditions, that Dr. Krieger participate in a drug treatment program and that, as an element of the program, Dr. Krieger participate in a program of random witnessed monitoring for controlled substances and alcohol on a frequency of not less than four times per month.

Pursuant to the board's Order, Dr. Krieger appeared before the board at its meeting of July 21, 1994. At that time, Dr. Krieger requested that the board eliminate from the drug screen panel the drug Cylert® (pemoline). The board considered the request on that date, and denied the request by its Order dated August 9, 1994

Pursuant to the board's Final Decision and Order, Dr. Krieger made his next annual appearance before the board on August 23, 1995. Based upon that appearance, and upon all other information of record herein, the board orders as follows:

ORDER

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that Dr. Krieger shall again appear before the board at the board's August, 1996, meeting.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Dr. Krieger shall continue in random witnessed screening of his blood or urine on a four times per month basis, and that the drug screen panel shall include the drug Cylert®.

1. REHEARING

Any person aggrieved by this order may file a written petition for rehearing within 20 days after service of this order, as provided in sec. 227.49 of the Wisconsin Statutes, a copy of which is reprinted on side two of this sheet. The 20 day period commences the day of personal service or mailing of this decision. (The date of mailing this decision is shown above.)

A petition for rehearing should name as respondent and be filed with the party identified in the box above.

A petition for rehearing is not a prerequisite for appeal or review.

2. JUDICIAL REVIEW.

Any person aggrieved by this decision may petition for judicial review as specified in sec. 227.53, Wisconsin Statutes a copy of which is reprinted on side two of this sheet. By law, a petition for review must be filed in circuit court and should name as the respondent the party listed in the box above. A copy of the petition for judicial review should be served upon the party listed in the box above.

A petition must be filed within 30 days after service of this decision if there is no petition for rehearing, or within 30 days after service of the order finally disposing of a petition for rehearing, or within 30 days after the final disposition by operation of law of any petition for rehearing.

The 30-day period for serving and filing a petition commences on the day after personal service or mailing of the decision by the agency, or the day after the final disposition by operation of the law of any petition for rehearing. (The date of mailing this decision is shown above.)
