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#### ORDER GRANTING FULL LICENSURE

On June 22, 1994, the Medical Examining Board issued its Final Decision and Order in the above-captioned matter. By the terms of the board's order, respondent's license to practice medicine and surgery in Wisconsin was limited to require that he comply with the terms and conditions of a disciplinary order issued by the State of Minnesota on January 14, 1994. This board's Order provided that prior to restoration of a full license in this state, respondent was to appear before the board.

On January 23, 1997, respondent appeared before the board, and the board considered his petition for return to full licensure. Based upon the entire record in this matter, including documentation of respondent's full compliance with the terms and conditions of his limited license, the board orders as follows:

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that all limitations on the license of Mark L. Thayer, M.D., to practice medicine and surgery in the State of Wisconsin, as imposed by the board's Final Decision and Order in this matter dated June 22, 1994, be, and hereby are, terminated, and Dr. Thayer is hereby returned to full licensure.
