ORDER ADOPTING STIPULATION

On December 5, 1994, Mary Ryan Rollman, filed an application for licensure by reciprocity to practice manicuring in Wisconsin. The information received in the application process reflects that from at least June 14, 1996 and until at least January 30, 1997, Ms. Rollman operated an unlicensed barbering and cosmetology establishment located at 1 East Geneva Street, Williams Bay, Wisconsin in violation of section 454 08(1)(b) of the Wisconsin statutes and Wisconsin Administrative Code §§ BC 3 01(1) and (2) and BC 3 03(5). The Board and Applicant have entered into a Stipulation by which the Board agreed to issue, and applicant agreed to accept a manicuring license subject to the following conditions. Based upon the stipulation and information of record herein, it is ORDERED as follows

ORDER

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that Mary Ryan Rollman is granted a manicuring license, subject to the following terms and conditions.

Mary Ryan Rollman shall pay to the Department of Regulation and Licensing a forfeiture of five hundred dollars (\$500 00). Upon receipt of the \$500.00 forfeiture, the Board shall issue applicant's manicuring license.

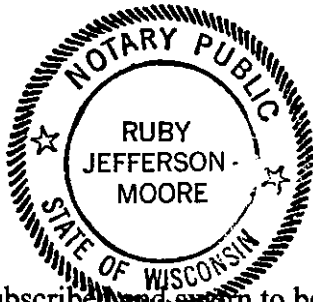
