ORDER ACCEPTING SURRENDER OF LICENSE

By its Final Decision and Order dated August 5, 1997, the Land Surveyor Section of the Examining Board of Architects, Landscape Architects, Professional Geologists, Professional Engineers, Designers and Land Surveyors accepted the voluntary surrender of Mr. Sargeant's registration as a land surveyor. Pursuant to the Stipulation which provided the basis for the board's Final Decision and Order, and as set forth in Finding of Fact #4 of that decision, Mr. Sargeant agreed that on or before October 1, 1997, he would also surrender his license to practice as a professional engineer in Wisconsin.

By letter of transmittal dated September 30, 1997, Mr. Sargeant surrendered his license to practice as a professional engineer. The professional Engineer Section of the board considered the matter at its meeting of November 14, 1997, and orders as follows:

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that the voluntary surrender by George W. Sargeant of his license to practice as a professional engineer in Wisconsin be, and hereby is accepted.

1. REHEARING

Any person aggrieved by this order may file a written petition for rehearing within 20 days after service of this order, as provided in sec. 227.49 of the Wisconsin Statutes, a copy of which is reprinted on side two of this sheet. The 20 day period commences the day of personal service or mailing of this decision. (The date of mailing this decision is shown above.)

A petition for rehearing should name as respondent and be filed with the party identified in the box above.

A petition for rehearing is not a prerequisite for appeal or review.

2. JUDICIAL REVIEW.

Any person aggrieved by this decision may petition for judicial review as specified in sec. 227.53, Wisconsin Statutes a copy of which is reprinted on side two of this sheet. By law, a petition for review must be filed in circuit court and should name as the respondent the party listed in the box above. A copy of the petition for judicial review should be served upon the party listed in the box above.

A petition must be filed within 30 days after service of this decision if there is no petition for rehearing, or within 30 days after service of the order finally disposing of a petition for rehearing, or within 30 days after the final disposition by operation of law of any petition for rehearing.

The 30-day period for serving and filing a petition commences on the day after personal service or mailing of the decision by the agency, or the day after the final disposition by operation of the law of any petition for rehearing. (The date of mailing this decision is shown above.)
