The parties having agreed to the stipulation attached, the Nursing Home Administrator Examining Board makes the following

### Findings of Fact

- 1. Respondent, Philip J. Castleberg, was born on October 18, 1949, and was granted Nursing Home Administrator license number 2194 on October 21, 1986. Respondent's most recent registration expired on July 1, 1996. Respondent resides at 1344 Longhill Drive, Apopka, FL 32712.
- 2. Respondent was the administrator of Villa Pines Living Center in Friendship, Wisconsin, from January 1990 to April 1995.
- 3. During the later part of his tenure as administrator of Villa Pines Living Center, Respondent was routinely absent from Villa Pines Living Center.

### Conclusions of Law

- 1. The Nursing Home Administrator Examining Board has jurisdiction in this matter pursuant to s. 456.10(2), Stats.
- 2. By his routine absence from Villa Pines during the later part of his tenure as administrator of the facility, Respondent violated s. NHA 5.02(2), Wis. Admin. Code.

### Order

Now, therefore, it is ordered that Philip J. Castleberg be and hereby is reprimanded.

It is further ordered that the license previously issued to Mr. Castleberg is LIMITED by the following conditions:

- a. Mr. Castleberg shall complete a 400 hour administrator in training program in Wisconsin under the supervision of James Deignan, a Wisconsin licensed nursing home administrator.
- b. For a period of 6 months including the AIT program, Mr. Castleberg shall maintain a record of his presence at the facility in which he is pursing the AIT program. At a minimum, the record shall be substantially equivalent to a time clock record.
- c. Mr. Castleberg or his supervisor will file monthly reports with the Department Monitor, Michelle Neverman, Division of Enforcement, P.O. Box 8935, Madison WI 53708 on or before the 5th of each month during the term of the six month period specified in (b). The Division of Enforcement shall audit Mr. Castleberg's records required under the preceding paragraph (b) by unannounced visit or inspection and investigation.
- d. The costs of complying with these conditions shall be the responsibility of Mr. Castleberg, but nothing in this Order prohibits Mr. Castleberg from receiving compensation for his services from any employer.
- e. The limitation shall be removed from Mr. Castleberg's license upon satisfactory proof of successful completion of the conditions set fort in the preceding paragraphs (a) through (d).

It is further ordered that Mr. Castleberg will pay the costs of this proceeding in the amount of \$1500.00 within thirty days of the date of this Order.

- 1. This stipulation is entered in resolution of the pending proceedings concerning Mr.

  Castleberg's license. The Stipulation and the proposed Final Decision and Order shall be presented directly to the Nursing Home Administrator Examining Board for its consideration and adoption.
- 2. For the purpose of resolving this matter without further expense or uncertainty of litigation, Mr. Castleberg consents to the entry of the attached Final Decision and Order without admirring any of the Facts stated therein or agreeing with any of the Conclusions of Law.
- 3. Mr. Castleberg is aware of and understands each of his rights, including:
  - the right to a hearing on the allegations against him, at which the state would have the burden of proving the allegations by a preponderance of the evidence.
  - the right to confront and cross-examine the witnesses against him.
  - the right to call witnesses on his own behalf and to compel their attendance by subpoena,
  - the right to testify himself,
  - the right to file objections to any proposed decision and to present briefs or oral arguments to the officials who are to render the final decision,
  - · the right to petition for rehearing,
  - the right to be represented at every stage of the proceeding, including the making of any stipulation, by an attorney of his choosing, at his own expense.
  - all other rights afforded to him under the United States Constitution, the Wisconsia Constitution, the Wisconsin Statutes and the Wisconsin Administrative Code.

### 1. REHEARING

Any person aggrieved by this order may file a written petition for rehearing within 20 days after service of this order, as provided in sec. 227.49 of the Wisconsin Statutes, a copy of which is reprinted on side two of this sheet. The 20 day period commences the day of personal service or mailing of this decision. (The date of mailing this decision is shown above.)

A petition for rehearing should name as respondent and be filed with the party identified in the box above.

A petition for rehearing is not a prerequisite for appeal or review.

### 2. JUDICIAL REVIEW.

Any person aggrieved by this decision may petition for judicial review as specified in sec. 227.53, Wisconsin Statutes a copy of which is reprinted on side two of this sheet. By law, a petition for review must be filed in circuit court and should name as the respondent the party listed in the box above. A copy of the petition for judicial review should be served upon the party listed in the box above.

A petition must be filed within 30 days after service of this decision if there is no petition for rehearing, or within 30 days after service of the order finally disposing of a petition for rehearing, or within 30 days after the final disposition by operation of law of any petition for rehearing.
