ORDER ADOPTING STIPULATION
97 BAC 007

On or about August 8, 1997, Avery Meeks and Anthony Oliphant, 6929 W Hampton Ave, Milwaukee, WI 53218 filed an application for a barbering and cosmetology establishment license for premises located at 6107 N Teutonia Ave., Milwaukee, WI 53209. The information received in the application process reflects that at least from January 23, 1997 until at least June 13, 1997, Mr. Meeks and Mr. Oliphant were operating Exodus Hair Studio, an unlicensed barbering and cosmetology establishment located at 6107 N Teutonia Ave, Milwaukee, WI 53209.

The above information is in violation of section 454.08(2)(a) of the Wisconsin statutes and Wisconsin Administrative Code §§ BC 3.01(1) and 3.04. The Board and Applicants have entered into a Stipulation by which the Board agreed to issue and applicants agreed to accept, a barbering and cosmetology establishment license subject to specified conditions. Based upon the stipulation and information of record herein, it is ORDERED as follows.

ORDER

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that Avery Meeks and Anthony Oliphant, d/b/a Exodus Hair Studio, are granted a barbering and cosmetology establishment license, subject to the following terms and conditions:


Applicants shall pay to the Department of Regulation and Licensing a forfeiture of Five Hundred dollars (\$500.00). Upon receipt of the \$500.00 forfeiture, the Board shall issue applicants' establishment license.



1. REHEARING

Any person aggrieved by this order may file a written petition for rehearing within 20 days after service of this order, as provided in sec. 227.49 of the *Wisconsin Statutes*, a copy of which is reprinted on side two of this sheet. The 20 day period commences the day of personal service or mailing of this decision. (The date of mailing this decision is shown above.)

A petition for rehearing should name as respondent and be filed with the party identified in the box above.

A petition for rehearing is not a prerequisite for appeal or review.

2. JUDICIAL REVIEW.

Any person aggrieved by this decision may petition for judicial review as specified in sec. 227.53, *Wisconsin Statutes* a copy of which is reprinted on side two of this sheet. By law, a petition for review must be filed in circuit court and should name as the respondent the party listed in the box above. A copy of the petition for judicial review should be served upon the party listed in the box above.

A petition must be filed within 30 days after service of this decision if there is no petition for rehearing, or within 30 days after service of the order finally disposing of a petition for rehearing, or within 30 days after the final disposition by operation of law of any petition for rehearing.

The 30-day period for serving and filing a petition commences on the day after personal service or mailing of the decision by the agency, or the day after the final disposition by operation of the law of any petition for rehearing. (The date of mailing this decision is shown above.)
