The parties in this matter agree to the terms and conditions of the attached Stipulation as the final decision of this matter, subject to the approval of the Board. The Board has reviewed this Stipulation and considers it acceptable.

Accordingly, the Board in this matter adopts the attached Stipulation and makes the following:

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. Pamela R. Bressler, 6237 W. Plainfield Ave., Greenfield, WI 53220 is duly licensed as a barbering and cosmetology manager in the state of Wisconsin (license #18355). This license was first granted on June 29, 1988.

2. Suite 105-A Salon, 823 N. 2nd St., Milwaukee, WI 53203, is duly licensed as a barbering and cosmetology establishment in the state of Wisconsin (license #24276). This license was first granted on June 12, 1995. Pamela R. Bressler is listed with the Department of Regulation and Licensing as the owner and manager of Suite 105-A Salon. As owner and

manager, Ms. Bressler was and is at all times relevant to this action responsible for compliance with ch. 454, Stats. and Wisconsin Administrative Code chs. BC 2, 3 and 4.

3. On exact dates unknown, but beginning at least in November 1996 and continuing on through at least June 5, 1997, Curtiss B. Leach rented a chair from Pamela R. Bressler at Suite 105-A Salon. At no time relevant to this action did Mr. Leach hold a barbering and cosmetology establishment license for the chair he was renting from Ms. Bressler.

4. On exact dates unknown, but beginning at least in November 1996 and continuing on through at least June 5, 1997, Nicholette C. Clauer rented a chair from Pamela R. Bressler at Suite 105-A Salon. At no time relevant to this action did Ms. Clauer hold a barbering and cosmetology manager license or establishment license for the chair she was renting from Ms. Bressler.

5. On exact dates unknown, but beginning at least in March 1997 and continuing on through at least June 5, 1997, Emelia DeJesus rented a chair from Pamela R. Bressler at Suite 105-A Salon. At no time relevant to this action did Ms. DeJesus hold a barbering and cosmetology manager license or establishment license for the chair she was renting from Ms. Bressler.

6. On exact dates unknown, but beginning at least in November 1996 and continuing on through at least June 5, 1997, Donald Brent Townsend rented a chair from Pamela R. Bressler at Suite 105-A Salon. At no time relevant to this action did Mr. Townsend hold a barbering and cosmetology manager license or establishment license for the chair he was renting from Ms. Bressler.

7. On exact dates unknown, but beginning at least in November 1996 and continuing on through at least June 5, 1997, Trent Wesley rented a chair from Pamela R. Bressler at Suite 105-A Salon. At no time relevant to this action did Mr. Wesley hold a current barbering and cosmetology practitioner license, nor did he hold a barbering and cosmetology manager license or establishment license for the chair he was renting from Ms. Bressler.

8. In resolution of this matter, Ms. Bressler consents to the entry of the following Conclusions of Law and Order.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

By the conduct referred to in ¶ 3-7, above, Pamela R. Bressler, d/b/a Suite 105-A Salon, violated sec. 454.15, Stats. and Wis. Admin. Code §§ BC 2.04 and BC 2.06.

ORDER

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NOW. THEREFORE, **IT IS HEREBY ORDERED** that Pamela R. Bressler shall pay to the Department of Regulation and Licensing a forfeiture of ONE THOUSAND SIX HUNDRED dollars (\$1600.00). Payment shall be submitted as follows:

\$400.00 due on or before October 15, 1997;
\$400.00 due on or before November 15, 1997;
\$400.00 due on or before December 15, 1997; and
\$400.00 due on or before January 15, 1998.



Bressler fail to timely submit payment of the forfeiture as set forth above, the establishment license of Suite 105-A Salon (#24276) **SHALL BE SUSPENDED**, without further notice or hearing, until Respondents have complied with the terms of this Order.



STIPULATION
96 BAC 141

It is hereby stipulated between Pamela R. Bressler, d/b/a Suite 105-A Salon, and Steven M. Gloe, Attorney for the Department of Regulation and Licensing, Division of Enforcement, as follows:

1. This Stipulation is entered into as a result of a pending investigation by the Division of Enforcement (96 BAC 141). Ms. Bressler consent to the resolution of this investigation by stipulation and without the issuance of a formal complaint.

2. Ms. Bressler understands that by the signing of this Stipulation she voluntarily and knowingly waive her rights, including: the right to a hearing on the allegations against her, at which time the state has the burden of proving those allegations by a preponderance of the evidence; the right to confront and cross-examine the witnesses against her; the right to call witnesses on her behalf and to compel their attendance by subpoena; the right to testify herself; the right to file objections to any proposed decision and to present briefs or oral arguments to the officials who are to render the final decision; the right to petition for rehearing; and all other applicable rights afforded to her under the United States Constitution, the Wisconsin Constitution, the Wisconsin Statutes and the Wisconsin Administrative Code.


3. Ms. Bressler is aware of her right to seek legal representation and has been provided an opportunity to obtain legal advice prior to signing this stipulation.

4. Ms. Bressler agrees to the adoption of the attached Final Decision and Order by the Barbering and Cosmetology Examining Board. The parties to the Stipulation consent to the entry of the attached Final Decision and Order without further notice, pleading, appearance or consent of the parties. Respondents waive all rights to any appeal of the attached order, if adopted in the form as attached.


5. If the terms of this Stipulation are not acceptable to the Board, the parties shall not be bound by the contents of this Stipulation, and the matter shall be returned to the Division of Enforcement for further proceedings. In the event that this Stipulation is not accepted by the Board, the parties agree not to contend that the Board has been prejudiced or biased in any manner by the consideration of this attempted resolution.

6. The parties to this stipulation agree that the attorney for the Division of Enforcement and the member of the Barbering and Cosmetology Examining Board assigned as an advisor in this investigation may appear before the Board for the purposes of speaking in support of this agreement and answering questions that the Board may have in connection with their deliberations on the stipulation.

7. The Division of Enforcement joins Ms. Bressler in recommending the Board adopt this Stipulation and issue the attached Final Decision and Order.



1. REHEARING

Any person aggrieved by this order may file a written petition for rehearing within 20 days after service of this order, as provided in sec. 227.49 of the *Wisconsin Statutes*, a copy of which is reprinted on side two of this sheet. The 20 day period commences the day of personal service or mailing of this decision. (The date of mailing this decision is shown above.)

A petition for rehearing should name as respondent and be filed with the party identified in the box above.

A petition for rehearing is not a prerequisite for appeal or review.

2. JUDICIAL REVIEW.

Any person aggrieved by this decision may petition for judicial review as specified in sec. 227.53, *Wisconsin Statutes* a copy of which is reprinted on side two of this sheet. By law, a petition for review must be filed in circuit court and should name as the respondent the party listed in the box above. A copy of the petition for judicial review should be served upon the party listed in the box above.

A petition must be filed within 30 days after service of this decision if there is no petition for rehearing, or within 30 days after service of the order finally disposing of a petition for rehearing, or within 30 days after the final disposition by operation of law of any petition for rehearing.

The 30-day period for serving and filing a petition commences on the day after personal service or mailing of the decision by the agency, or the day after the final disposition by operation of the law of any petition for rehearing. (The date of mailing this decision is shown above.)
