ORDER ADOPTING STIPULATION

On September 9, 1998, John W. Wilson filed his application for a license to practice as a practical nurse in the State of Wisconsin. Because Mr. Wilson indicated on his application that he had criminal convictions, he was requested to appear before the board on November 6, 1998, in support of his application.

The board and Mr. Wilson thereafter entered into a Stipulation, by which the Board of Nursing (board) agreed to grant, and John W. Wilson (Mr. Wilson) agreed to accept, a limited license to practice nursing in the State of Wisconsin. Based upon that Stipulation, the Board of Nursing orders as follows:

ORDER

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that John W. Wilson, LPN, is hereby granted a license to practice as a practical nurse in the State of Wisconsin imposing the following terms and conditions:

- 1. Upon a showing by Mr. Wilson of complete, successful and continuous compliance for a period of one year with the terms of limitation outlined below, he may petition for return of full licensure. The board may, in its discretion, require that Mr. Wilson complete at least six months of nursing employment monitored under the conditions outlined below prior to the board's issuance of a complete and unrestricted license.
- 2. The department monitor is the individual designated by the board as its agent to coordinate compliance with the terms of this Order, including: receiving and coordinating all reports and petitions; and requesting additional monitoring and surveillance. - 3. Mr. Wilson shall arrange for quarterly reports from his nursing employer(s) reporting the terms and conditions of his employment and evaluating his work performance. These reports shall be submitted to the department monitor in the Department of Regulation and Licensing, Division of Enforcement, P.O. Box 8935, Madison, WI 53708, on a schedule as directed by the department monitor. An employer shall report immediately to the department monitor (FAX 608 266-2264, telephone 608 267-7139) any violation or suspected violation of the board's Order.
- 4. Applicant shall report to the board any change in employment status, change of residence address or phone number, within five days of any such change.
- 5. Violation of any of the terms of the board's Order may be construed as conduct imperiling public health, safety and welfare and may result in summary suspension of Mr. Wilson's license. The board in its discretion may in the alternative deny a renewal of the license or impose additional conditions and limitations for violation of any of the terms and conditions.

The effective date of the board's Order adopting the terms of this Stipulation shall be the date of its signing.
