On June 24, 1994, the State of Wisconsin Pharmacy Examining Board issued an *Order Reinstating and Limiting License* in the above-captioned matter. Among the terms and conditions set forth in the board's order was that Ms. Redman obtain random, witnessed screens for the presence of all controlled substances and alcohol. Under the Order, Ms. Redman is currently required to obtain four screens every month.

It has been requested that that the number of required screens be reduced from four per month to twice a month. In reviewing the file and other information in this matter, the board agreed that a reduction would be appropriate. However, it is the board's opinion that Ms. Redman should be required to obtain 3 screens per month.

ORDER

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the requirement that Ms Redman participate in random, witnessed collection of urine and/or blood specimens for monitoring for the presence of all controlled substances, including in particular but not limited to Tetrahydrocannabinols, and alcohol in her blood and/or urine at least four (4) times per month, is reduced to three (3) times per month.
