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ORDER GRANTING STAY

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On October 22, 1997, the Medical Examining Board issued its Final Decision and Order in the above-captioned matter. By the terms of the board's order, respondent's license to practice medicine and surgery in Wisconsin was suspended for a period of not less than five years, with provision for consecutive three month stays of the suspension contingent upon compliance with a number of conditions and limitations on the license. Among other conditions, Dr. Goy was required to enroll and successfully participate in a drug and alcohol treatment program satisfactory to the board, including participation in individual or group therapy on at least a weekly basis; to participate in AA or NA meetings at least once per week; to submit to drug and alcohol screens on a twice-weekly basis; to be responsible for submission of quarterly practice and therapy reports; and to participate in continuing education in prescribing controlled substances and in record-keeping.

Pursuant to the board's Order, Dr. Goy appeared before the board at its meeting of January 22, 1998, in support of his request for a further three month stay of the suspension. The board considered the request on that date, and granted the stay.

The board considered Dr. Goy's request for a further stay at its meeting of April 22, 1998. Based upon respondent's request, and upon all other information of record herein, the board orders as follows:

ORDER

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that the stay of the suspension of the license of Peter W. Goy, M.D. is extended for an additional period of three months.


