The parties in this matter agree to the terms and conditions of the attached Stipulation as the final decision of this matter, subject to the approval of the Board. The Board has reviewed this Stipulation and considers it acceptable.

Accordingly, the Board in this matter adopts the attached Stipulation and makes the following:

### FINDINGS OF FACT

1. Patricia A. Knuth (DOB 12-17-48) 3277 S. Dayfield Ave., Milwaukee, WI 53207, is duly licensed as a barbering and cosmetology practitioner in the state of Wisconsin (license #27500). This license was first granted on July 11, 1968.

- 2. Hilarie L. Knuth (DOB 01-02-71) 2215 S. Mound St., Milwaukee, WI 53207, is duly licensed as a manicurist in the state of Wisconsin (license #733). This license was first granted on April 19, 1990.
- 3. C R Nails, 120 W. Howard Ave., Milwaukee, WI 53207, is duly licensed as a manicuring establishment in the state of Wisconsin (license #248). This license was first granted on April 28, 1993. Patricia A. Knuth and Hilarie L. Knuth are listed with the Department of Regulation and Licensing as the owners of C R Nails. As owners, Patricia Knuth and Hilarie Knuth were and are at all times relevant to this action responsible for compliance with ch. 454, Stats. and Wisconsin Administrative Code chs. BC 2, 3 and 4.
- 3. C R Nails' establishment license expired on July 1, 1993 and was not renewed until December 16, 1997. At all times relevant to this action, C R Nails was operating as a manicuring establishment.
- 4. In resolution of this matter, Patricia A. Knuth and Hilarie L. Knuth consent to the entry of the following Conclusions of Law and Order.

### **CONCLUSIONS OF LAW**

By the conduct referred to in ¶ 3, above, Patricia A. Knuth and Hilarie L. Knuth, d/b/a C R Nails, violated secs. 454.08(9) and 454.15(2)(i), Stats. and Wis. Admin. Code § BC 2.04.

#### ORDER

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Patricia Knuth and Hilarie Knuth, d/b/a C R Nails shall pay to the Department of Regulation and Licensing a forfeiture of ONE THOUSAND dollars (\$1000.00). Payment shall be submitted as follows:

\$250.00 due on or before May 15, 1998;

\$250.00 due on or before July 15, 1998; and

\$250.00 due on or before September 15, 1998.

\$250.00 due on or before November 15, 1998;

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that in the event Respondents fail to timely submit any payment of the forfeiture as set forth above, the establishment license of C R Nails (#248) SHALL BE SUSPENDED, without further notice or hearing, until Respondents have complied with the terms of this Order.

This Order shall become effective upon the date of its signing.

It is hereby stipulated between Patricia A. Knuth and Hilarie L. Knuth, d/b/a C R Nails, personally on their own behalf and Steven M. Gloe, Attorney for the Department of Regulation and Licensing, Division of Enforcement, as follows:

- 1. This Stipulation is entered into as a result of a pending investigation by the Division of Enforcement (97 BAC 161). Patricia Knuth and Hilarie Knuth consent to the resolution of this investigation by stipulation and without the issuance of a formal complaint.
- 2. Patricia Knuth and Hilarie Knuth understand that by the signing of this Stipulation they voluntarily and knowingly waive their rights, including: the right to a hearing on the allegations against them, at which time the state has the burden of proving those allegations by a preponderance of the evidence; the right to confront and cross-examine the witnesses against them; the right to call witnesses on their behalf and to compel their attendance by subpoena; the right to testify themselves; the right to file objections to any proposed decision and to present briefs or oral arguments to the officials who are to render the final decision; the right to petition for rehearing; and all other applicable rights afforded to them under the United States Constitution, the Wisconsin Constitution, the Wisconsin Statutes and the Wisconsin Administrative Code.
- 3. Patricia Knuth and Hilarie Knuth are aware of their right to seek legal representation and have been provided an opportunity to obtain legal advice prior to signing this stipulation.
- 4. Patricia Knuth and Hilarie Knuth agree to the adoption of the attached Final Decision and Order by the Barbering and Cosmetology Examining Board. The parties to the Stipulation consent to the entry of the attached Final Decision and Order without further notice, pleading, appearance or consent of the parties. Respondents waive all rights to any appeal of the attached order, if adopted in the form as attached.
- 5. If the terms of this Stipulation are not acceptable to the Board, the parties shall not be bound by the contents of this Stipulation, and the matter shall be returned to the Division of Enforcement for further proceedings. In the event that this Stipulation is not accepted by the

Board, the parties agree not to contend that the Board has been prejudiced or biased in any manner by the consideration of this attempted resolution.

- 6. The parties to this stipulation agree that the attorney for the Division of Enforcement and the member of the Barbering and Cosmetology Examining Board assigned as an advisor in this investigation may appear before the Board for the purposes of speaking in support of this agreement and answering questions that the Board may have in connection with their deliberations on the stipulation.
- 7. The Division of Enforcement joins Patricia Knuth and Hilarie Knuth in recommending the Board adopt this Stipulation and issue the attached Final Decision and Order.

#### NOTICE OF RIGHTS OF APPEAL

TO: PATRICIA A KNUTH AND HILARIE L KNUTH, d/b/a C R NAILS

You have been issued a Final Decision and Order. For purposes of service the date of mailing of this Final Decision and Order is  $\frac{4/14/98}{}$  Your rights to request a rehearing and/or judicial review are summarized below and set forth fully in the statutes reprinted on the reverse side.

#### A. REHEARING.

Any person aggreeved by this order may file a written petition for rehearing within 20 days after service of this order, as provided in section 227.49 of the Wisconsin Statutes. The 20 day period commences on the day of personal service or the date of mailing of this decision. The date of mailing of this Final Decision is shown above.

A petition for rehearing should name as respondent and be filed with the party identified below.

A petition for rehearing shall specify in detail the grounds for relief sought and supporting authorities. Rehearing will be granted only on the basis of some material error of law, material error of fact, or new evidence sufficiently strong to reverse or modify the Order which could not have been previously discovered by due diligence. The agency may order a rehearing or enter an order disposing of the petition without a hearing. If the agency does not enter an order disposing of the petition within 30 days of the filing of the petition, the petition shall be deemed to have been denied at the end of the 30 day period.

A petition for rehearing is not a prerequisite for judicial review.

### B. JUDICIAL REVIEW.

Any person aggreed by this decision may petition for judicial review as specified in section 227.53, Wisconsin Statutes (copy on reverse side). The petition for judicial review must be filed in circuit court where the petitioner resides, except if the petitioner is a non-resident of the state, the proceedings shall be in the circuit court for Dane County. The petition should name as the respondent the Department, Board, Examining Board, or Affiliated Credentialing Board which issued the Final Decision and Order. A copy of the petition for judicial review must also be served upon the respondent at the address listed below.

A petition for judicial review must be served personally or by certified mail on the respondent and filed with the court within 30 days after service of the Final Decision and Order if there is no petition for rehearing, or within 30 days after service of the order finally disposing of a petition for rehearing, or within 30 days after the final disposition by operation of law of any petition for rehearing. Courts have held that the right to judicial review of administrative agency decisions is dependent upon strict compliance with the requirements of sec. 227.53 (1) (a), Stats. This statute requires, among other things, that a petition for review be served upon the agency and be filed with the clerk of the circuit court within the applicable thirty day period.

The 30 day period for serving and filing a petition for judicial review commences on the day after personal service or mailing of the Final Decision and Order by the agency, or, if a petition for rehearing has been timely filed, the day after personal service or mailing of a final decision or disposition by the agency of the petition for rehearing, or the day after the final disposition by operation of the law of a petition for rehearing. The date of mailing of this Final Decision and Order is shown above.

The petition shall state the nature of the petitioner's interest, the facts showing that the petitioner is a person aggrieved by the decision, and the grounds specified in section 227.57, Wisconsin Statutes, upon which the petitioner contends that the decision should be reversed or modified. The petition shall be entitled in the name of the person serving it as Petitioner and the Respondent as described below.
