The parties in this matter agree to the terms and conditions of the attached Stipulation as the final decision of this matter, subject to the approval of the Board. The Board has reviewed this Stipulation and considers it acceptable.

Accordingly, the Board in this matter adopts the attached Stipulation and makes the following:

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. Valentine Salon, 555 W. Brown Deer Rd., Fox Point, WI 53217, is duly licensed as a barbering and cosmetology establishment in the state of Wisconsin (license #25795). This license was first granted on June 13, 1996. Mila Rosen, Lilya Batuner and Irene Skylar are listed with the Department of Regulation and Licensing as the owners of Valentine Salon. As owners, Ms. Rosen, Ms. Batuner and Ms. Skylar were and are at all times relevant to this action responsible for compliance with ch. 454, Stats. and Wisconsin Administrative Code chs. BC 2, 3 and 4.
2. On exact dates unknown, but beginning at least in August 1997 and continuing on through July 30, 1998, Larisa Tarnovsky was employed at Valentine Salon to provide aesthetic services to the public. At no time relevant to this action did Ms. Tanovsky hold a valid and current Wisconsin aesthetician license.
3. In resolution of this matter, Mila Rosen, Lilya Batuner and Irene Skylar consent to the entry of the following Conclusions of Law and Order.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

By the conduct referred to in ¶ 2, above, Mila Rosen, Lilya Batuner and Irene Skylar, d/b/a Valentine Salon, violated sec. 454.15(2)(i), Stats. and Wis. Admin. Code §BC 2.04(1).

ORDER

NOW, THEREFORE, **IT IS HEREBY ORDERED** that Mila Rosen, Lilya Batuner and Irene Skylar, d/b/a Valentine Salon shall pay to the Department of Regulation and Licensing a forfeiture of FIVE HUNDRED dollars (\$500.00). Payment shall be submitted within sixty (60) days from the date of this order. Payment shall be made by **certified check or money order**, payable to the Wisconsin Department of Regulation and Licensing and sent to:

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that in the event Mila Rosen, Lilya Batuner and Irene Skylar fail to timely submit payment of the forfeiture as set forth above, the establishment license of Valentine Salon (#25795) **SHALL BE SUSPENDED**, without further notice or hearing, until Respondent has complied with the terms of this Order.
