The parties in this matter agree to the terms and conditions of the attached Stipulation as the final decision of this matter, subject to the approval of the Board. The Board has reviewed this Stipulation and considers it acceptable.

Accordingly, the Board in this matter adopts the attached Stipulation and makes the following:

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. Sharon K. Hansen (DOB 10-19-58), 1305 National Ave., Oshkosh, WI 54901 is duly licensed in the state of Wisconsin as a barbering and cosmetology manager (license #21077). This license was first granted on September 10, 1984.
2. On exact dates unknown, but at least on July 10, 1998, Shairon's was operating as a barbering and cosmetology establishment. At no time relevant to this action was Shairon's licensed as a Wisconsin barbering and cosmetology establishment.
3. In resolution of this matter, Ms. Hansen, d/b/a Shairon's, consents to the entry of the following Conclusions of Law and Order.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

By the conduct referred to in ¶ 2, above, Sharon K. Hansen, d/b/a Shairon's, violated secs. 454.08(1)(b) and 454.15(2)(i), Stats. and Wis. Admin. Code §§ BC 2.03(6) and BC 2.04.

ORDER

NOW, THEREFORE, **IT IS HEREBY ORDERED** that Sharon K. Hansen, d/b/a Shairon's, shall pay to the Department of Regulation and Licensing a forfeiture of ONE HUNDRED dollars (\$100.00). Payment shall be submitted within thirty (30) days from the date of this order.
