The parties in this matter agree to the terms and conditions of the attached Stipulation as the final decision of this matter, subject to the approval of the Board. The Board has reviewed this Stipulation and considers it acceptable.

Accordingly, the Board in this matter adopts the attached Stipulation and makes the following:

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. Chreesha Thi Hong Nguyen (DOB 01-25-68) of 11029 W. Wildwood Ln. #H203, West Allis, WI 53227, is duly licensed as a manicurist in the state of Wisconsin (license #3622). This license was first granted on October 26, 1998.
2. Nail Arts, 2500 N. Mayfair Rd., Wauwatosa, WI 53226, is duly licensed as a manicuring establishment in the state of Wisconsin (license #726). This license was first granted on June 6, 1996.
3. On exact dates unknown, but at least on October 23, 1998, Chreesha Thi Hong Nguyen was employed at Nail Arts to provide manicuring services to the public. At no time relevant to this action did Ms. Nguyen hold a valid and current Wisconsin manicurist license.
4. In resolution of this matter, Ms. Nguyen consents to the entry of the following Conclusions of Law and Order.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

By the conduct referred to in ¶ 3, above, Chreesha Thi Hong Nguyen, violated sec. 454.04(1)(d), Stats.

ORDER

NOW, THEREFORE, **IT IS HEREBY ORDERED** that Chreesha Thi Hong Nguyen, shall pay to the Department of Regulation and Licensing a forfeiture of ONE HUNDRED dollars (\$100.00). Payment shall be submitted within 30 days from the date of this order.
