ORDER SUSPENDING THE LICENSE
On July 11, 1997, the Board of Nursing issued its Final Decision and Order in the above-captioned matter. By the terms of the board's Order, Ms. Green's license was suspended for an indefinite period. The Order provided that Ms. Green could petition at any time for a three month stay of the suspension of her license, and could apply for subsequent three month stays upon satisfactory compliance during the previous three month period with conditions and limitations on her license.

By letter dated June 2, 1998, Ms. Green petitioned for a stay of the suspension of her license. In her letter, Ms. Green indicated that she agreed to "work away from medications and outside of direct patient care." The board considered the request at its meeting of July 9, 1998, and granted the petition by its Order dated July 18, 1998.

On July 9, 1999, the board considered a report by the department monitor that to that date, Ms. Green had neither complied with the terms and conditions of her limited license nor applied for an extension of the stay. Accordingly,

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that the stay of the suspension of the license of Mary Green, R.N., is terminated, and the license is hereby suspended, effective on the date hereof.
