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ORDER

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On July 9, 1998, the Board of Nursing issued its Final Decision and Order in the above-referenced matter by which Ms. Stanley's license to practice as a registered nurse in Wisconsin was limited to require that she meet essentially the same conditions imposed by the Illinois Department of Professional Regulation following a disciplinary action brought by that state against Ms. Stanley's Illinois nursing license. By letter dated December 8, 1998, Ms. Stanley notified the board that the probation involving her nursing license in Illinois had been terminated, and she requested that the limitations on her Wisconsin license be terminated as well.

Because the department monitor had difficulty obtaining information from the Illinois board relating to the disciplinary action there, and was unable as well to obtain an assessment carried out in Illinois as a part of the Illinois order, the board at its meeting of May 14, 1999, decided that Ms. Stanley should obtain a current assessment prior to acting on her request.

At its meeting of July 9, 1999, the board again took up the matter of Ms. Stanley's license. Ms. Stanley had in the interim provided the board with the assessment done in Illinois, however that assessment was done three years previously. Accordingly,

IT IS ORDERED that the matter Ms. Stanley's request for a return to full licensure shall be tabled until Ms. Stanley provides to the board a current assessment establishing to the satisfaction of the board that she is able to safely and competently practice without limitations or conditions on the license.
