ORDER GRANTING FULL LICENSURE
On September 18, 1998, the Board of Nursing issued its Final Decision and Order in the above-captioned matter. By the terms of the board's order, respondent's license to practice as a registered nurse in Wisconsin was suspended for a period of not less than one year, with provision for grant of successive three-month stays of the suspension conditioned upon compliance with certain requirements and limitations on the license. The Order provided that upon successful compliance for a period of one year with the terms and conditions, the board would grant respondent's petition for a return to full licensure.
On November 5, 1999, the board considered respondent's petition for return to full licensure. Based upon the entire record in this matter, including documentation of respondent's full compliance with the terms and conditions of her limited license, the board orders as follows:
<u>ORDER</u>
NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that all limitations on the license of Karen C. Sieben, R.N., to practice professional nursing in the State of Wisconsin, as imposed by the board's Final Decision and Order in this matter dated September 18, 1998, be, and hereby are, terminated, and Ms. Sieben is hereby returned to full licensure.
