ORDER GRANTING UNLIMITED LICENSE
On March 27, 1998, Ms. Jennifer L. Lebby filed her application for a license to practice as a registered nurse in the State of Wisconsin. Because Ms. Lebby indicated on her application that she had been convicted of disorderly conduct on two occasions, she was asked to appear before the board for oral interview. Ms. Lebby appeared before the board at its meeting of July 9, 1998, and the board considered the application on that date. The board and Ms. Lebby thereafter entered into a Stipulation, by which the board agreed to grant and Ms. Lebby agreed to accept, a limited license requiring that Ms. Lebby attend therapy for a period of one year, and that she submit quarterly therapy and work reports during that period.
On September 17, 1999, the board considered Ms. Lebby's request that the limitations on her license be terminated. Based upon evidence that Ms. Lebby has satisfactorily complied with all limitations on her license for the requisite period, the board orders as follows;
<u>ORDER</u>
NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that all limitations on the license of Jennifer L. Lebby, RN, to practice as a professional nurse in Wisconsin are terminated, and Ms. Lebby is reinstated to full licensure.
