ORDER GRANTING STAY

On January 29, 1999, the Board of Nursing issued its Final Decision and Order in the above-captioned matter. By the terms of the board's order, respondent's license to practice as registered nurse in Wisconsin was suspended for an indefinite period. The Order specified that respondent could petition at any time for a stay of the suspension upon submission of proof that she is participating in an acceptable treatment program, and submission of an evaluation establishing that she may safely and reliably practice as a professional nurse. On March 5, 1999, the board considered Ms. McLean's request that the suspension of her license be stayed.

Based upon respondent's request, and upon all other information of record herein, the board orders as follows:

ORDER

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that the request of Susan M. McLean, R.N., for a three month stay of suspension of her license is granted. Ms. McLean may request further three month stays, and any such request shall be granted upon demonstration of her having fully complied with the terms and conditions of the board's January 29, 1999 Order during the preceding three month period.
