ORDER GRANTING FULL LICENSURE

On March 13, 1997, the Board of Nursing issued its Final Decision and Order in the above-captioned matter. By the terms of the board's order, respondent's license to practice as a registered nurse in Wisconsin was limited for an indefinite period to require that respondent practice only under the general supervision of another registered nurse and that she continue to participate in a mental health treatment program with a health care provider acceptable to the board.

By letter dated September 9, 1997, respondent requested that the limitations on her license be terminated. The board considered the request at its meeting of September 12, 1997, and denied the request by its order dated September 25, 1997.

by letter dated March 26, 1999, Ms. Averill again requested that the limitations on her license be terminated. Based upon Ms. Averill's request, and upon all other information of record herein, the board orders as follows:

ORDER

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that the petition of Christina Averill, R.N., that the limitations on her license be terminated be, and hereby is, granted, and Ms. Averill is reinstated to full licensure.
