On June 24, 1994, the State of Wisconsin Pharmacy Examining Board issued an *Order Reinstating and Limiting License* in the above-captioned matter in which the board placed certain enumerated conditions and limitations upon the license of Denise A. Redman, R.Ph., to practice pharmacy.
