ORDER REINSTATING STAY

A meeting of the State of Wisconsin Pharmacy Examining Board was held on July 13, 1999, during which the board reviewed a request by Kevin M. Pampuch for a reinstatement of the stay of suspension of his license to practice pharmacy.

Based upon the information presented, the Pharmacy Examining Board makes the following:

FINDINGS OF FACT

- 1. Kevin M. Pampuch, respondent herein, 370 W. Lagoon Lane, Apt. 1416, Oak Creek, Wisconsin 53154, was issued a license to practice pharmacy in the State of Wisconsin, number 12635, on April 18, 1997.
- 2. By a *Final Decision and Order* dated March 10, 1999, the State of Wisconsin Pharmacy Examining Board ordered the suspension of respondent's license for a period of not less than five (5) years. The decision provided for successive three (3) month stays of the suspension upon petition by respondent and continuing compliance with the terms of the Order, which included a requirement that he enter a treatment program, and submit various required reports regarding his continued sobriety and compliance with certain monitoring and treatment provisions.
- 3. On June 16, 1999, the board issued an *Order* based upon respondent's violation of the order of March 10, 1999, and reinstated the five (5) year suspension of respondent's license to practice pharmacy.
- 4. On July 13, 1999, the board reviewed documentation indicating that the respondent had come into compliance with the terms and conditions previously imposed by the *Final Decision and Order* dated March 10, 1999.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

The State of Wisconsin Pharmacy Examining Board has jurisdiction in this proceeding pursuant to Chapter 450, Stats., the provisions within the order of the *Final Decision and Order* dated March 10, 1999, and the provisions within the *Order* dated June 16, 1999.

ORDER

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that the license of the respondent, Kevin M. Pampuch, to practice pharmacy shall be and hereby is reinstated.

FURTHERMORE, IT IS ORDERED that the license reinstated to respondent shall be, and hereby is suspended for a period of not less than five (5) years; but that the suspension is stayed for a period of three (3) months, conditioned upon compliance with all of the terms and limitations contained within the *Final Decision and Order* dated March 10, 1999.

FURTHERMORE, IT IS ORDERED that this Order is effective on July 13, 1999.
