ORDER RESTORING FULL LICENSURE

On July 11, 1997, the Board of Nursing issued its Final Decision and Order in the above-captioned matter. By the terms of the board's order, respondent's license to practice as a professional nurse in Wisconsin was limited to require that she arrange for quarterly work reports from her employer, and that she complete within six months eight hours of continuing education in stress management.

On January 29, 1999, the board considered Ms. Quandt's request that the limitations on her license be terminated. Based upon that request, and upon evidence of Ms. Quandt's full compliance with the terms and conditions on her license, the board orders as follows:

ORDER

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that all limitations on the license of Michelle A. Quandt, RN, to practice as a professional nurse in Wisconsin are lifted, and Ms. Quandt is hereby restored to full licensure.
