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ORDER MODIFYING TERMINATING STAY

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On February 24, 1999, the Medical Examining Board issued its Final Decision and Order in the above-captioned matter. By the terms of the board's order, respondent's license to practice as a respiratory care practitioner in Wisconsin was limited to require, among other conditions that she participate in all components of an alcohol and drug treatment program, submit to drug and alcohol screens on a twice-weekly basis, and that she be responsible for submission of quarterly reports from her employer and from her supervising health care provider. The first such reports were due on June 1, 1999, and as of the date of the board's meeting on August 25, 1999, no reports had been received despite repeated written reminders from the Department Monitor. Moreover, respondent has failed to apply for renewal of the stay as required by the Order.

Based upon respondent's failure to comply with the board's Final Decision and Order, and upon all other information of record herein, the board orders as follows

ORDER

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that the stay of the suspension of Ms. Rogers' license is hereby terminated, and her license to practice respiratory care is hereby suspended.
