On April 14, 1998, the State of Wisconsin Pharmacy Examining Board issued a *Final Decision and Order* in the above-captioned matter. Among the terms and conditions were that Ms. Kuhrt participate in individual and/or group therapy sessions at least once a week. By a *Modification of Order* (February, 1999), the board reduced the required therapy sessions to not less than twice monthly.

Ms. Kuhrt has requested that the required individual therapy sessions be reduced to once a month. This is supported by her counselor, who also requests that the group therapy requirement be eliminated. On August 11, 1999, the board considered the request, and granted it as follows:

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the requirement that Marilyn L. Kuhrt, R.Ph., participate in individual therapy sessions not less than twice a month, is reduced to requiring such participation not less than once monthly. Ms. Kuhrt is not required to participate in group therapy sessions.

FURTHERMORE, IT IS ORDERED that in all other respects, the previous orders of the board in this matter remain in full force and effect.
