On August 12, 1998, the State of Wisconsin Pharmacy Examining Board issued a *Final Decision and Order* in the above-captioned matter. Among the terms and conditions were that Mr. Moon could not be employed nor work in the capacity of a "pharmacist in charge", as defined in Phar 1.02 (9), Wis. Adm. Code, and that he participate in individual and/or group therapy sessions at least once a week. By virtue of a *Modification of Order (February 1999)*, Mr. Moon was permitted one hour of unsupervised practice per day and his therapy sessions were reduced to twice monthly.

Mr. Moon has requested that all restrictions on his ability to act as pharmacist in charge be removed, and that his therapy sessions be reduced to once a month. On October 13, 1999, the board considered the requests of Mr. Moon.

The board granted the request to reduce therapy sessions to once a month.

The board did not grant Mr. Moon's request that the limitation on his ability to act as a pharmacist-in-charge be totally eliminated. The board's approach historically has been to permit a gradual increase in the number of unsupervised practice hours as a licensee's recovery progresses. In this case, the board believes that Mr. Moon should be permitted to work 8 unsupervised hours per week. These hours may be consecutive at the discretion of his employer. However, although Mr. Moon may open or close the pharmacy, he may not both open and close the pharmacy on the same day.

Based upon the foregoing,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Craig W. Moon, R.Ph. may act as a pharmacist in charge within the meaning of section Phar 1.02 (9), Wis. Adm. Code, and thereby perform professional pharmacy services without the continuous presence and supervision of another licensed pharmacist for a maximum of eight (8) hours per week. Mr. Moon may open or close the pharmacy, however he may not both open and close the pharmacy on the same day.

Moon Modification Order

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FURTHERMORE, IT IS ORDERED that the requirement that Mr. Moon participate in individual and/or group therapy sessions not less than twice monthly, is reduced to requiring such participation not less than once monthly.

FURTHERMORE, IT IS ORDERED that in all other respects, the previous orders of the board in this matter remain in full force and effect.
