ORDER EXTENDING THE STAY

On July 27, 1995, the Medical Examining Board issued its Final Decision and Order in the above-captioned matter. By the terms of the board's order, respondent's license to practice medicine and surgery in Wisconsin was suspended for five years, with provision for consecutive three month stays of the suspension conditioned upon compliance with certain limitations on the license. Among these were that Dr. Galvani participate in a drug treatment program, one element of which was that he submit to random blood or urine screens on a twice-weekly basis.

Dr. Galvani appeared before the board pursuant to the board's Order on July 24, 1996. At that time, he petitioned the board for a reduction in the number of required urine screens. The board considered the request on that date, and granted the request by its Order dated August 3, 1998.

On November 19, 1998, and February 24, 1999, the board considered Dr. Galvani's requests for further three month stays of the suspension of his license, and granted the stays by its Orders dated November 27, 1998, and March 5, 1999.

On July 22, 1999, Dr. Galvani made his annual appearance before the board. His request for a further stay of the suspension of his license was considered by the board on that date, and the board orders as follows:

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that the suspension of the license of Theodore J. Galvani, Jr., M.D., is hereby stayed for an additional period of three months. Dr. Galvani shall again appear before the board at its July, 2000, meeting.
