ORDER SUSPENDING THE LICENSE

On May 14, 1999, the Board of Nursing issued its Final Decision and Order in the above-captioned matter. By the terms of the board's order, respondent's license to practice as a registered nurse in Wisconsin was limited for at least two years to require that she abstain from the use of alcohol and controlled substances, that she participate in program of random witnessed monitoring for controlled substances and alcohol in her blood or urine on a frequency of not less twice each week, that she practice only under the supervision of an RN in a work setting approved by the board, and that she be responsible for submission of quarterly work reports by her employer.

On November 5, 1999, the board considered evidence that respondent has complied with none of the limitations on her license. Under the board's Order, violation of any of the terms of the board's Order shall be construed as conduct imperiling public health, safety and welfare and may result in summary suspension of respondent's license. Accordingly,

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that the license of Mauri Lynn Fowler to practice as a licensed practical nurse in Wisconsin is suspended, effective immediately.
