ORDER GRANTING STAY

On March 5, 1999, the Board of Nursing issued its Final Decision and Order in the above-captioned matter. By the terms of the board's order, respondent's license to practice as registered nurse in Wisconsin was suspended for not less than one year. The Order specified that respondent could petition at any time for a stay of the suspension upon submission of proof that she is participating in an acceptable treatment program, and submission of an evaluation establishing that she may safely and reliably practice as a professional nurse. Also on March 5, 1999, the board considered Ms. Britton's request that the suspension of her license be stayed.

Based upon respondent's request, and upon all other information of record herein, the board orders as follows:

ORDER

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that the request of Cheryl L. Britton, R.N., for a three month stay of suspension of her license is granted. Ms. Britton may request further three month stays, and any such request shall be granted upon demonstration of her having fully complied with the limitations on her license during the preceding three month period.
