**ORDER STAYING SUSPENSION**

On May 21, 1998, the Wisconsin Chiropractic Examining Board issued a Final Decision and Order (1) suspending Dr. Russell's license for a period of not less than thirty days, (2) staying the suspension for a period of three months, and (3) permitting Dr. Russell to apply for successive three-month extensions of the stay upon compliance with certain limitations.

As reported to the board on December 16, 1999 by department compliance monitor Ted Nehring, Dr. Russell has continued to comply with the limitations. Therefore,

**IT IS ORDERED that the suspension of the license to practice chiropractic granted to Larry E. J. Russell, D.C., is stayed for a period of three months from the date of this order.**
