ORDER GRANTING FULL LICENSURE

On May 8, 1998, the Board of Nursing issued its Final Decision and Order in the above-captioned matter. By the terms of the board's order, respondent's license to practice as a licensed practical nurse in Wisconsin was limited to require that within six months, she successfully complete at least eight hours of continuing education in the area of stress management, and at least eight hours of continuing education in geriatric nursing. The Order also provided that Ms. Cline be responsible for submission of quarterly work reports from her employer for a period of at least one year.

On May 14, 1999, the board considered evidence of Ms. Cline's compliance with the terms of her limited license. Based upon that evidence, the board orders as follows:

ORDER

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that all limitations on the license of Kay E. Cline to practice as a licensed practical nurse in Wisconsin are terminated, and Ms. Cline is reinstated to full licensure.
