ORDER RESTORING FULL LICENSURE

On July 23, 1998, the Medical Examining Board issued its Final Decision and Order in the above-captioned matter. By the terms of the board's order, respondent was reprimanded, and respondent's license to practice medicine and surgery in Wisconsin was limited to require that within 12 months of the board's Order, Dr. Harman complete 15 hours of Category I continuing education in the area of orthopedic diagnosis, and 15 hours in the area of risk management.

At its meeting of June 23, 1999, the board considered Dr. Harman's request that the board accept a course in risk management completed prior to the board's Order in partial satisfaction of the Order, and that the deadline be extended to November, 1999, in order to permit her to attend a program to be conducted in October, 1999. The board denied that request.

On August 25, 1999, the board considered evidence that Dr. Harman had in fact completed all continuing education required by the board's July 23, 1998 Order. Based upon that evidence, the board orders as follows:

ORDER

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that all limitations on the license of Jill Pamela Harman, M.D., are terminated, and Dr. Harman is therefore reinstated to full licensure.
