The parties in this matter agree to the terms and conditions of the attached Stipulation as the final decision of this matter, subject to the approval of the Board. The Board has reviewed this Stipulation and considers it acceptable.

Accordingly, the Board in this matter adopts the attached Stipulation and makes the following:

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. Sau Thi Dinh (D.O.B. 01/01/60), 250 S. Edwards Blvd., #84, Lake Geneva, WI 53147 is duly licensed as a manicurist in the state of Wisconsin (license #2716). This license was granted on December 10, 1996, based upon Ms. Dinh's licensure in Kansas as a manicurist.
2. Ms. Dinh's licensure in Kansas was granted based upon her licensure in Florida.

3. On or about November 3, 1997, Ms. Dinh’s Florida manicurist license was revoked. The Florida Board of Cosmetology found that Ms. Dinh had obtained her Florida license based upon false representations that she had completed required training for this license at Artistic Nail Academy, a Florida manicuring school.

4. In resolution of these proceedings, Ms. Dinh consents to entry of the following Conclusions Of Law and Order.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

By the conduct referred to above, Sau Thi Dinh is subject to disciplinary action against her manicurist license, pursuant to sec. 454.15(2), Stats.

ORDER

NOW, THEREFORE, **IT IS HEREBY ORDERED** that Sau Thi Dinh shall **SURRENDER** her individual license to practice as manicurist in the State of Wisconsin (license #2716) as well as the establishment license for Long Nails Salon (license #946). Ms. Dinh shall immediately return all license cards, certificates and/or other indicia of licensure to the Board. Should Ms. Dinh reapply for licensure in Wisconsin, the Board may in its sole discretion determine whether, and under what terms and conditions, a license may be issued.

This Order shall become effective on the date of its signing.
