ORDER MODIFYING THE LIMITED LICENSE

On April 22, 1998, the Medical Examining Board issued its Final Decision and Order in the above-captioned matter. By the terms of the board's order, Dr. Koziol's license to practice medicine and surgery in Wisconsin suspended for a period of not less than five years with provision for granting successive three-month stays of the suspension upon submission to the board of proof satisfactory to the board that Dr. Koziol had satisfactorily complied with the terms and conditions set forth in the Order during the previous three month period.

At its meeting of November 19, 1998, the board considered Dr. Koziol's request that he be granted a stay of the suspension. Also considered was a letter from Jae Yong Shim, M.D. agreeing to act as Dr. Koziol's mentor, as required by the Order. By its Order dated November 27, 1998, the stay was granted and Dr. Shim was approved to act as Dr. Koziol's designated Professional Mentor during the term of the limited license

On January 20, 1999, the board considered evidence of violation by Dr. Koziol of the terms and conditions of his limited license. Dr. Koziol appeared to explain the circumstances of those violations, and the board extended the stay of the suspension of his license for a further three months.

On February 24, 1999, the board considered Dr. Koziol's request that the frequency of required therapy be reduced from once per week to once every two weeks. Dr. Engel supported that modification. Based upon Dr. Koziol's request, and upon other information of record, the board orders as follows:

ORDER

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that the frequency of required individual and/or group therapy sessions required under section 2 of the board's Final Decision and Order in this matter dated April 22, 1998, is hereby reduced from one session per week to one session every two weeks.
