The parties in this matter agree to the terms and conditions of the attached Stipulation as the final decision of this matter, subject to the approval of the Board. The Board has reviewed this Stipulation and considers it acceptable.

Accordingly, the Board in this matter adopts the attached Stipulation and makes the following:

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. Kayla Marie Miller (DOB 12-12-50) is duly licensed as a dental hygienist in the state of Wisconsin (license # 3080). This license was first granted on June 22, 1982.
2. Ms. Miller's most recent address on file with the Wisconsin Dentistry Examining Board is P.O. Box 122, St. Nazianz, WI 54232.
3. On September 30, 1995, Ms. Miller's dental hygienist license expired. Ms. Miller did not submit payment to renew her license until March 5, 1998. During that period of time, Ms. Miller worked part-time, approximately 12 hours per week, as a dental hygienist for Dr. Ron Eagan, D.D.S., in St. Nazianz, Wisconsin.
4. In resolution of this matter, Ms. Miller consents to the entry of the following Conclusions of Law and Order.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

1. The Dentistry Examining Board has jurisdiction in this matter pursuant to sec. 447.07, Stats.
2. Kayla Marie Miller, by the conduct described in paragraph 3, above, has violated sec. 447.07(3)(f), Stats. and Wisconsin Administrative Code §§ DE 2.03(2) and DE 5.02(16).

ORDER

NOW, THEREFORE, **IT IS HEREBY ORDERED** that Kayla Marie Miller is **REPRIMANDED**.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Kayla Marie Miller shall pay to the Department of Regulation and Licensing a forfeiture of ONE THOUSAND dollars (\$1000.00). Payments shall be submitted as follows:

\$100.00 due on or before February 15, 1999; \$100.00 due on or before July 15, 1999;
\$100.00 due on or before March 15, 1999; \$100.00 due on or before August 15, 1999;
\$100.00 due on or before April 15, 1999; \$100.00 due on or before Sept. 15, 1999;
\$100.00 due on or before May 15, 1999; \$100.00 due on or before Oct. 15, 1999; and
\$100.00 due on or before June 15, 1999; \$100.00 due on or before Nov. 15, 1999.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that in the event Kayla Marie Miller fails to submit any payment of the forfeiture as set forth above, the dental hygienist license of Ms. Miller (#3080) **SHALL BE SUSPENDED**, without further notice or hearing, until Ms. Miller has complied with the terms of this Order.

This Order shall become effective upon the date of its signing.
