The parties in this matter agree to the terms and conditions of the attached Stipulation as the final decision of this matter, subject to the approval of the Board. The Board has reviewed this Stipulation and considers it acceptable.

Accordingly, the Board in this matter adopts the attached Stipulation and makes the following:

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. Jay N. Bhore, M.D. (DOB 09/12/15) is duly licensed to practice medicine and surgery in the state of Wisconsin (license #16226.) This license was first granted on November 2, 1967. Dr. Bhore specializes in psychiatry.
2. Dr. Bhore's most recent address on file with the Wisconsin Medical Examining Board is 1543 N. Prospect Ave., Milwaukee, WI 53202.
3. A formal investigation, 98 MED 275, is pending before the Wisconsin Medical Examining Board. The investigation is based upon an investigation by the Federal Bureau of Investigation, Complaint No. 209A-MW-30988, which, among other things, relates to allegations of Medicaid fraud.
4. Dr. Bhore has voluntarily agreed that he will surrender his license to practice medicine and surgery in the state of Wisconsin; that he will not apply for a license to practice medicine and surgery in the state of Wisconsin; and that he will not renew or attempt to renew his registration in the state of Wisconsin at any time in the future.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

1. The Medical Examining Board has jurisdiction in this matter pursuant to sec. 448.02(3), Stats.
2. The Medical Examining Board has authority to enter into this stipulated resolution of this matter pursuant to secs. 227.44(5) and 448.02(5), Stats.

ORDER

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the stipulation of the parties is approved.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that:

1. Jay N. Bhore shall SURRENDER his license to practice medicine and surgery in the state of Wisconsin (license # 16226).
2. Dr. Bhore shall not apply for a license to practice medicine and surgery in the state of Wisconsin and shall not renew or attempt to renew his registration to practice medicine and surgery in the state of Wisconsin at any time in the future.
3. Dr. Bhore shall return his wall certificate and wallet registration to the Board.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the pending investigation 98 MED 275 shall be and hereby is closed without further proceedings.
